



Online Checkout Terms – Effective as of October 2019

The  online checkout allows you to make convenient and more secure online purchases with an eligible American Express Card (“Card”) wherever you see the  icon. The agreement between you and your Card Issuer, as well as these  Online Checkout Terms, apply to the use of your Card with the  online checkout.

Your Data & Privacy

By using the  online checkout, you authorize and direct American Express to provide your personal information, including your Card and shipping information to the merchant to process your transaction. American Express has no control over the privacy and data security practices of merchants; it is always your responsibility to review the merchant’s privacy policies and terms and conditions before making a purchase.

Shared Devices & Authorized Access

It is your responsibility to make sure that no one else can use your Card in the  online checkout. If you use the  online checkout on a shared device or a device that another person can access (for example, if another person knows your device passcode or has a fingerprint registered on your device), you should not select “Remember Me on this Device”, as it will allow that person to use your Card in the  online checkout.

You represent that you are authorized to access and use the Card account and credentials that you are using to make a purchase with the  online checkout. You also agree that you will not: (i) disrupt the normal flow of information or otherwise act in a manner that negatively affects other users’ ability to use the  online checkout; (ii) interfere with or disrupt the  online checkout (including, without limitation, servers or networks associated with the  online checkout), or (iii) violate any requirements, procedures, policies or regulations of networks associated with the  online checkout.

Lost, Stolen or Compromised Device

If a device on which you use the  online checkout is lost, stolen or compromised in any way (for example, through a virus or spyware), call your Card Issuer immediately at the telephone number on the back of your Card.

Online Checkout Unavailability

On rare occasions, the  online checkout may be down, unavailable or not working properly. It is your responsibility to ensure you have your Card account information or an alternative payment method to complete your purchase. We will not be liable to you if you cannot complete a purchase at your time of choosing, if the purchase price increases or if you miss out on a purchase.

Canceling, Suspending or Changing Access to the Online Checkout: Revisions to these Online Checkout Terms

We may cancel, suspend or change your access to the  online checkout at any time. We may also revise these  Online Checkout Terms at any time. We will update the Effective Date above when we do so.

Complying with Laws

You must always use the  online checkout in accordance with applicable laws. You must not interfere or disrupt the operation of the  online checkout in a way that might negatively impact others or cause any loss to American Express. These  Online Checkout Terms are subject to the laws of the same country as your agreement between you and your Card Issuer.
